Assessments are available in-person or d streaming with limited seating to ensure you receive thorough, personalized feedback.

Touch Therapies:

Touch Therapy will not be required during your assessment.

Qualifications:

- Complete a set number of designated workshops from each category.
- o The participating Professional Skin Therapist must possess a valid license.
- The participating Professional Skin Therapist must be currently employed with an active Dermalogica Business Account.
- A model is required and must be provided by the participating Professional Skin Therapist.

What to expect during your assessment:

 Participants will be required to perform a service of their choice (from the service list) on a model provided by the Professional Skin Therapist.

The assessment will focus on the following key aspects:

Communication:

- Effective communication with the client/model to assess their skin needs and determine if there are any considerations/contraindications.
- o Addressing client/model concerns and providing relevant skincare recommendations.
- Verbally explain to your observing instructor the reason for your product selections and application methods (i.e. power up or power down).



Product Selection:

- Demonstrating the ability to choose appropriate products for the selected service.
- o Knowledge of product ingredients and their benefits for specific skin concerns.

Technique Execution:

- Proper Dermalogica application techniques relevant to the chosen service.
- o Adherence to Dermalogica best practices and safety protocols.

Observation and Evaluation:

- Participants will be observed by a Dermalogica Instructor to ensure correct product application and technique execution.
- o Instructors will provide constructive feedback on areas of strength and improvement.

Assessment Details:

- Participants will contact the Education Guidance Team to register for a 2-hour assessment workshop. Lesson plan will include instructor overview, expectations and allow time for one-to-one feedback. Your hands portion will include 60-minutes to perform Consultation, FaceMapping and 30 min service protocol. This added time allows for interactive communication with your assessment instructor.
- Equipment and Products: All necessary equipment and products will be provided inperson by the Learning Loft.
- D streaming participants are required to have all products and equipment necessary to perform the selected service protocol.

Attire:

- Participants should arrive on time and dress in appropriate professional attire for skincare services.
- Long hair should be pulled back, minimal jewelry and short nails are recommended.
